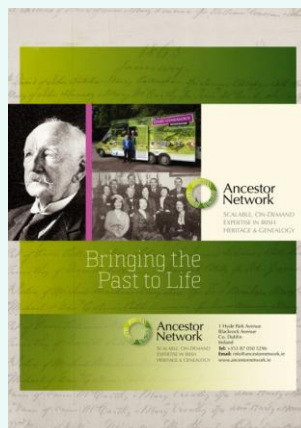

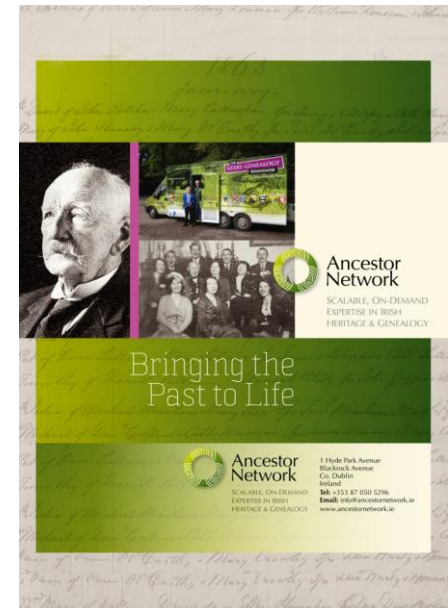

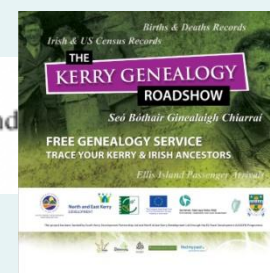

- ★ **Family History** - a more detailed or narrative account of families.

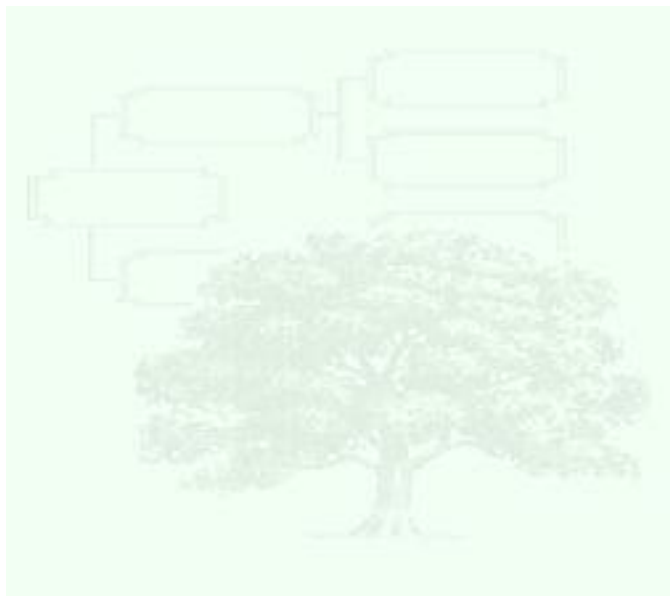
Genealogy / Family History

As in history, in genealogy we are concerned with establishing facts through careful and critical documentary research.

Getting Started

- ✦ Speak to family members. Record as much as you can.
- ✦ Work from what you know to what you don't know, generation by generation
- ✦ Draw up a family tree, a.k.a. a pedigree sheet
- ✦ Familiarise yourself with the relevant geographic and administrative Districts
- ✦ Organise your files
- ✦ Verify family legend with written records if you can
- ✦ Cross check your sources
- ✦ How far back can you go?

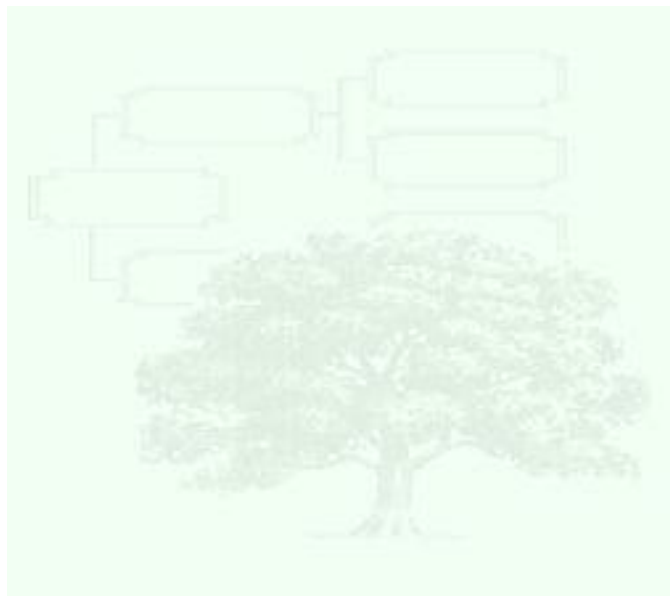

Origins and Meanings of Surnames

Monogenetic surnames have a single origin from one individual family; possible examples are Feerick or Hamrock.

Polygenetic surnames arose independently in different places and at different times, examples being Murphy or Smith.

Surnames can be further divided into four broad classes:-

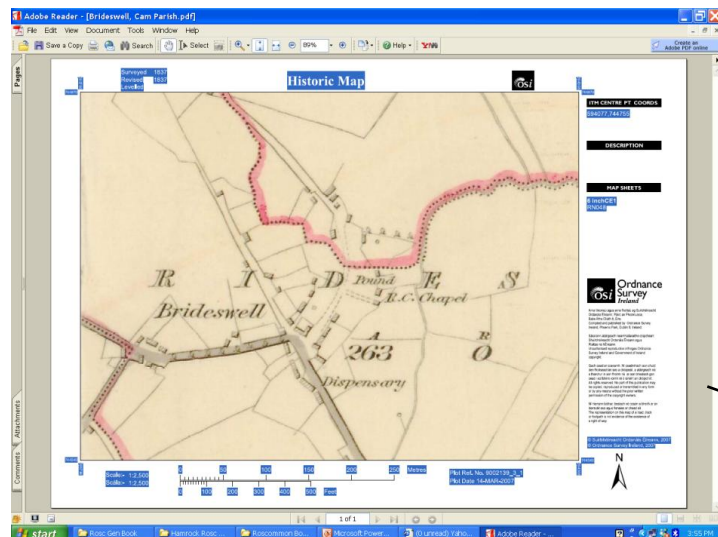
Ancestral personal names or patronymics – examples; O'Brian, McCarthy, Thompson, Martin

Placenames or toponymics derived from placenames – examples; Pembroke, Fleming

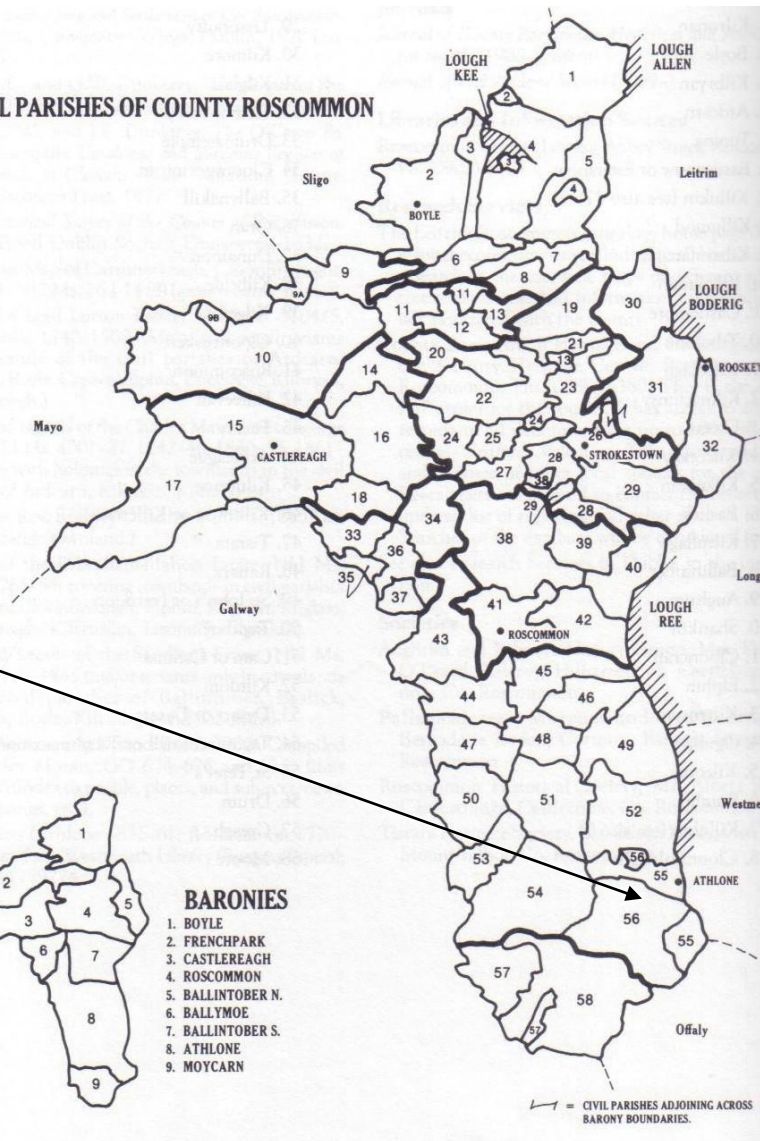
Occupational names derived from trade or status – example; Smith, Miller

Descriptive names referring to an individual's person or appearance – examples; Short, Beauregard

Civil Registration

- General Register Office – searching and copying costs can add up
- www.groireland.ie
- Births – from 1864
- Marriages – non-Catholic marriages from 1845, all marriages from 1864
- Deaths – from 1864
- www.familysearch.org – free internet access from home
- www.findmypast.ie and www.ancestry.co.uk subscription websites
- People in Dublin can access BMD registers for free at Gilbert Library on Pearse Street

- Useful Tips
 - Check all variations of name spelling; e.g., Mahony, Mahoney, O'Mahoney
 - Unnamed children. Check for male or female entries
 - Checking marriages – these are indexed under the bride and groom surnames

Census Records

- 1901 and 1911 Census Returns are only that survive and accessible for entire country (freely available on www.nationalarchives.ie)
- Census returns for Ireland commenced in 1821
- Fragments only survive for Census Returns pre-1901
 - Lost in Public Records Office Explosion in 1922 Civil War

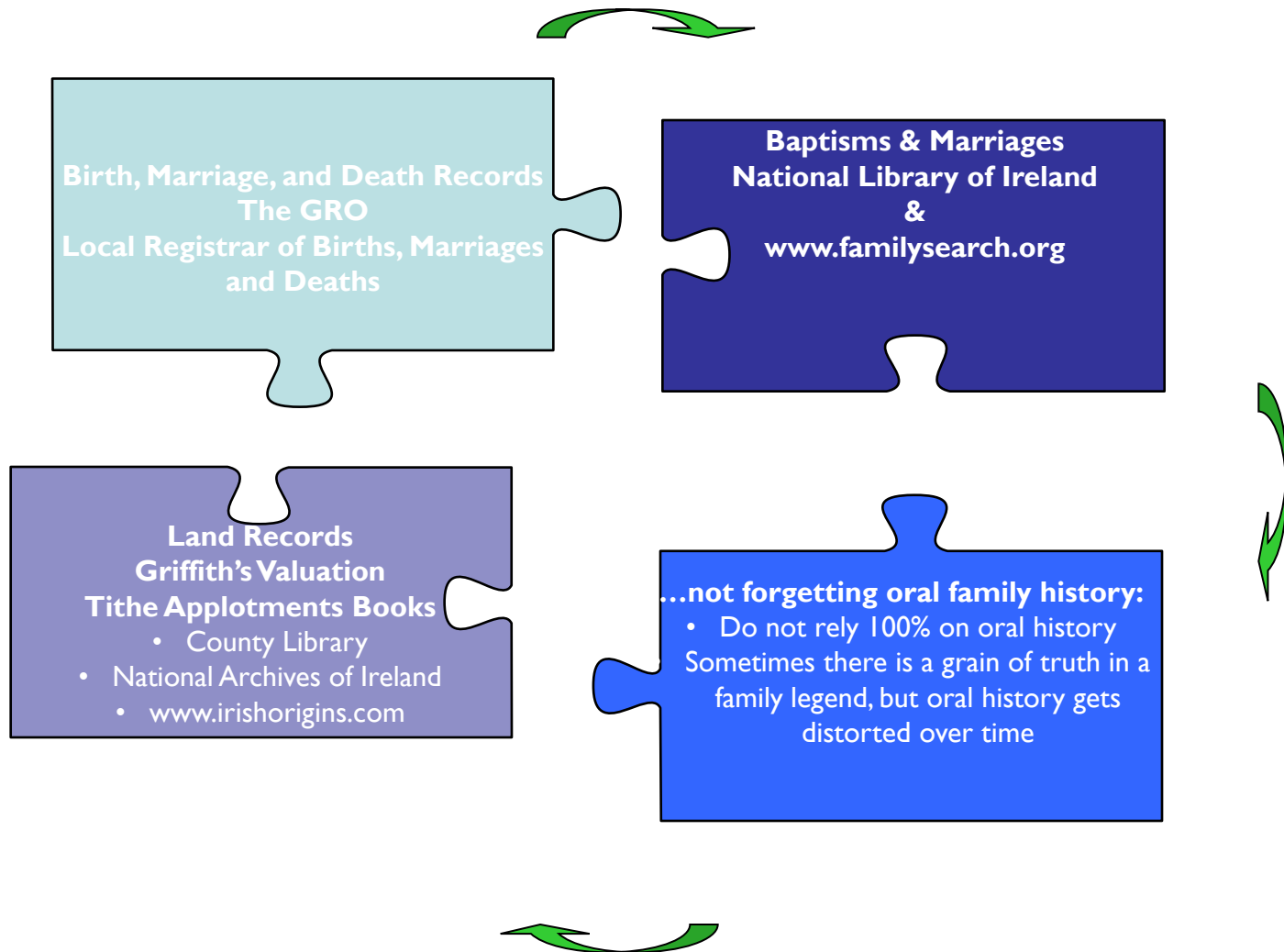

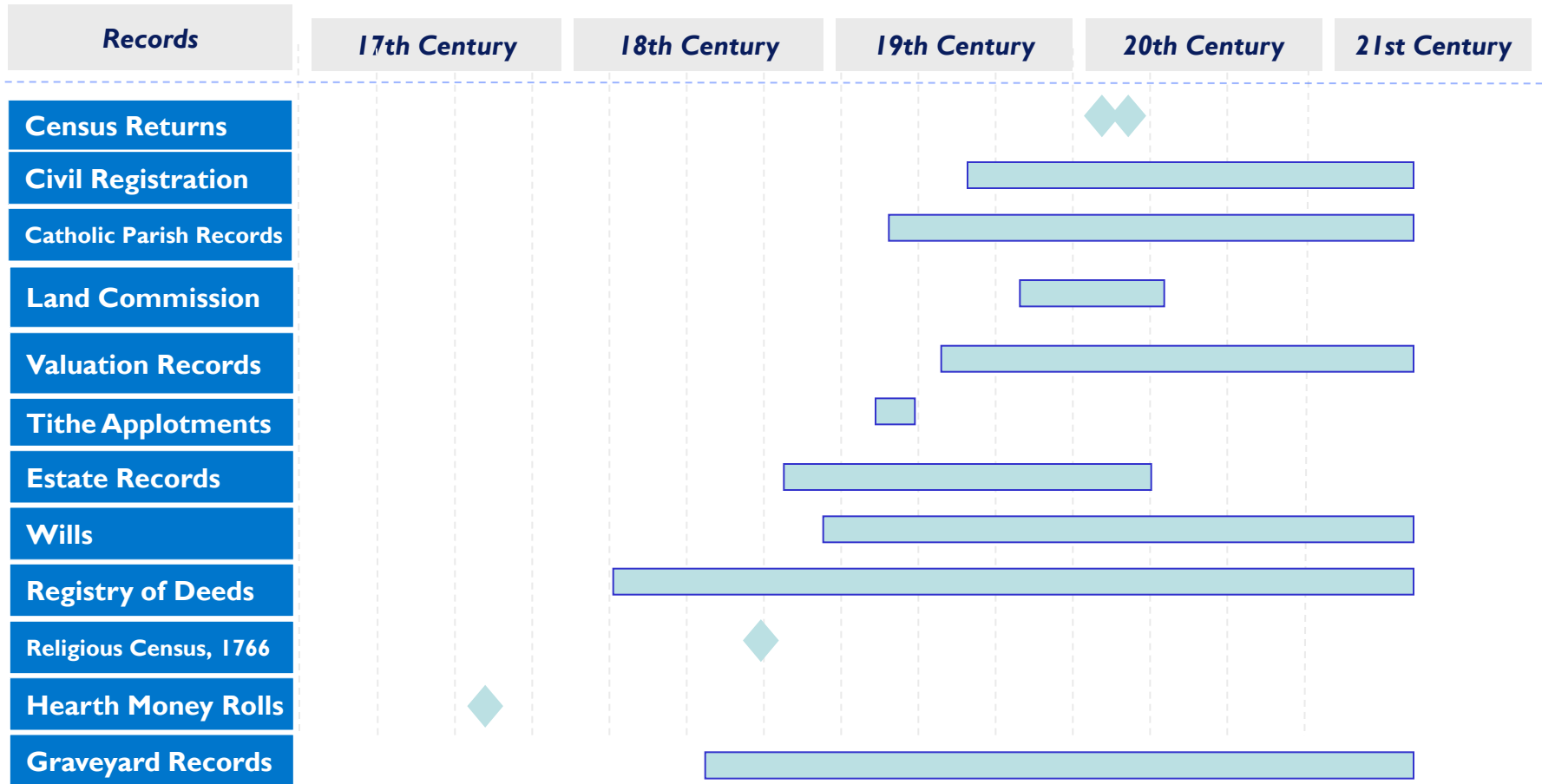

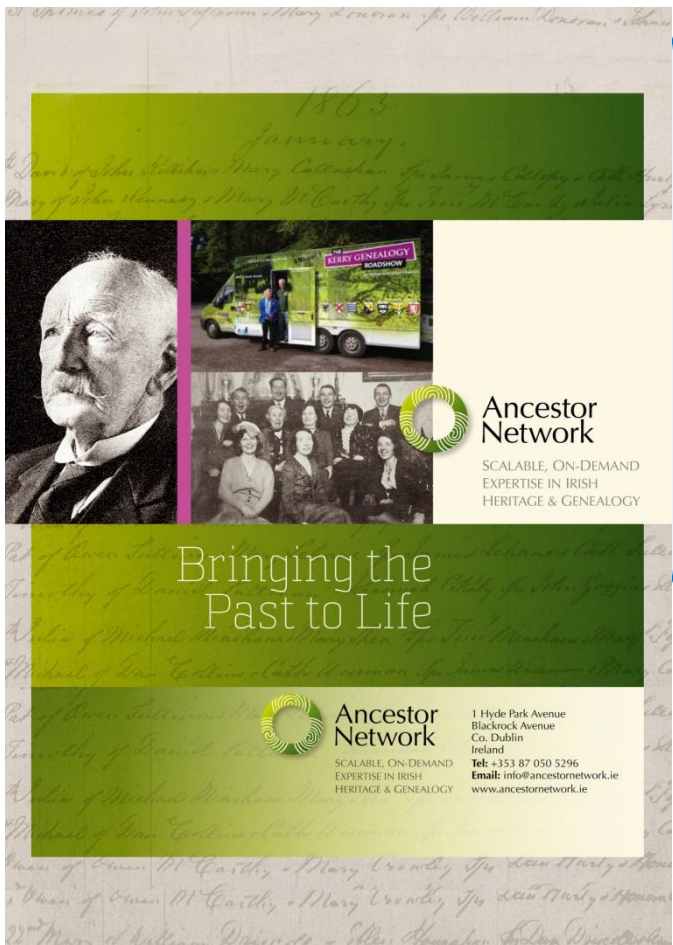
